IMPORTANT: If you are off campus, you must first connect to the RIT VPN.

Mac OS

- From Finder, click the Go menu, and then select Connect to Server.
- Type in the address of the share you want to access and click Connect. Below are some available shares and their addresses.




• When prompted, enter your RIT username and password, and click Connect. You should now see a window pop up with the file share.

Windows

 $\bullet \ \ \, \text{Click the Start menu and then select Run. Alternatively, hold the Windows key and type the letter "R".}$



• Type in the address of the share you want to access and click OK. Below are some available shares and their addresses.

• When prompted, enter in your RIT username and password and click OK. Important: If your first login attempt fails, enter your username with 'MAIN\' like this: MAIN\abc1234. This will force your personal computer to authentication against RIT's directory.
