- You will no longer get home-use codes from CADTech directly. You will need to go to the link below and follow the steps to get access to software.
- Foundry has switched to a third party verification app – Proxi.id – to streamline their process.
- **CRUCIAL!!** When applying for your free student license, enter the university name exactly as **Rochester Institute of Technology** . This will help avoid any issues when applying for your free license.
