Your receiving a message that the Database is corrupt and needs to be rebuilt

Solution

- 1. While holding down the "OPTION" key on your keyboard, launch Outlook 2011
- 2. You will notice the Microsoft Database Utility launches instead

- 4. Click Rebuild

5. Presented with a dialog that will ask you to Quit All Microsoft Applications. Click "Quit All"
